The St Johns Park Bowling Club Group are seeking expressions of interest for the role of Head Coach. The Head Coach will oversee the full-time development and coaching of its bowling members. The role would include elements such as conducting individual coaching sessions, creating coaching development plans for members, conducting group coaching sessions periodically, overseeing the development of all pennant sides, benchmarking and talent identification across SJP Bowling Club membership. This position works predominantly after hours and particularly on weekends. The role will involve some travel with sides across Sydney, NSW and potentially interstate. The role requires current Bowls Australia Coaching Accreditation and a NSW Working With Children Check.

The role would likely suit those who identify coaching as their priority. Whilst participation of playing will be considered it is not the priority of the position.

Key Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

Pennants

- Develop seasonal planning for male and female pennant sides.
- Conduct training and information sessions for pennant sides.
- Identify opportunities for players within our squads.

One on One Coaching

- Provide individual coaching sessions to assist members of all abilities improve.
- Create session/seasonal plans to support bowling members.

Group Coaching Sessions

- Provide regular group coaching sessions with a range of development focuses.

Junior Bowlers

- Create a development program for Junior participants.
- Conduct junior development training sessions.
- Coordinate and conduct the Junior Schools program.
- Be actively recruiting junior participants.

Friday Mixed Social, Business House Competitions & new opportunities

- Assist the Social Committee bring new bowlers into the sport.
- Conduct a range of competitions to assist bringing new bowlers into the competition.
- Play with and help develop new bowlers of all ages.

Benchmarking/Talent Identification

- Undertake a range of benchmarking tasks for the bowling membership.
- Identify talent within Bowls Programs.
- Recruit identified talent, in conjunction with the Group Sports Administrator.

Supporting Bowls Administration

- Undertake bowls administration tasks to ensure the smooth running of bowls at SJP.
- Contribute to online coaching content for Saints TV, the website and other content forms.
- Help with conducting tournaments, Social Competitions and other bowls activities.
- Other tasks as requested by Management.
